As you know, the City of Toronto is currently conducting a Land Use Study of the Quarry Lands in preparation for possible development. This is your chance to find out where things stand and to make your feelings known!

It is **critical** that as many people as possible attend this meeting to make sure that any and all development proposals are i) consistent with the unique character and fabric of our community; and ii) would be undertaken only after a full examination, analysis and suitable action plan to deal with the many unanswered environmental questions associated with this site.

Councillors Brian Ashton, Sandra Bussin, Gerry Altobello and Janet Davis will be at the meeting along with city planners working on the file. MPP Lorenzo Berardinetti has also been invited. From 7 pm to 8 pm will be an Open House where residents can examine the city's preliminary report. At 8 pm the City will make a formal presentation, followed by questions.
